➤ Last Monday there was a **Diocesan Partnership Meeting in Foxrock Parish Pastoral Centre about the 'Building Hope Process'**. **Statement of Mission:** The great social, cultural and religious change of our time brings challenges and opportunities for all people – both for people of faith and for people who do not see themselves in this way. In response, the Archdiocese of Dublin has initiated a process of review and renewal, and is providing a Statement of Mission as a starting point for reflection and conversation in each parish and

in the diocese as a whole. **Mission:** Encounter with the person of Jesus makes us who we are, and shapes what we do. Being at the service of this encounter is the heart of our mission. The living Christ calls and empowers the Dublin Archdiocese to act with resolve and become more fully a place of welcome and compassion, which embodies the power, hope and joy of the gospel.

➤ **Parish Pastoral Council (PLT)** met on Thursday evening last. After an **opening prayer** we did an exercise in **acknowledging all the different activities, ministries in the parish**. The plan now is to look and reflect on all these activities, ministries and promote them going forward in the context of a Parish Community. The Parish is in the process of advertising the Parish Secretary's job on the Dublin Diocesan Website. We are also looking at the Code of Conduct and Complaints Protocols for the Parish. **Safeguarding** reports issues regarding the processing of vetting forms, this will be dealt with soon. We also talked about what **'Partnership'**, i.e. five parishes working together means, and at what stage of that process we are at. For the next meeting the PLT members will read the **Task Force Report**, this will give the PLT a better insight into the Partnership process. We finished the meeting with a prayer.
